We were excited to meet Sofia, a teenager who began attending while we were gone; as well as Magda who had visited once months ago but now is coming on a regular basis. Both individuals know someone in our church who personally invited them. Everyone in our church has arrived at a personal invitation from someone else in the church or was told about our church from someone they knew and trusted. Those personal connections make a huge difference here.

In June we were able to host two missionary families in our home. The first was family of seven who needed a place to stay upon first arriving until they could travel to their new place of service on the other side of the country. The second (Kevin and Ruthann Pardo) was a couple on a survey trip to see where in Paraguay the Lord would have them serve. We praise the Lord for His provision of a home where we have been able to host other missionary families and visitors from the US.

Bro. Kevin Pardo is Bolivian; therefore, Spanish is his first language. While they were here, Jim asked Bro. Kevin to speak at our Saturday youth meeting.
